

Redbourn Parish Council Photography Competition 2021

Terms and Conditions

Redbourn Parish Council is the organiser of the Redbourn Photography Competition 2021. By accepting the Terms & Conditions of the competition and subsequently submitting your photographs, you have entered into an agreement with the organiser who reserves the right to modify these terms and conditions without notice.

1. Competition entry

By entering the competition, you agree to fully comply with these terms and conditions. The competition opens on Monday 15th February 2021 and closes on Saturday 1st May 2021 at 23:59.

2. Eligibility Criteria

The competition is open to anyone of any age with the following exceptions: Members of the Redbourn Parish Council Photography Competition Working Party. Under 18s must have permission to enter from their parent/guardian. In submitting an entry for the competition, the parent/guardian is deemed to have given consent and agreed to entry as described in these terms and conditions.

3. Photograph Format and Entry Categories

Photographs must be digitally submitted (either smartphone or digital camera) a resolution of 300 pixels per inch at A4 (i.e., image dimensions of at least 1920 x 1080 pixels) in JPG/JPEG file format, maximum file size 10MB. If you are unsure there is a free app called "Image Size" which resizes images for you.

The organiser reserves the right to crop and enhance where appropriate photographs.

All photographs submitted must have been taken in Redbourn about one of the following 6 categories:

- Spring
- View from my window
- Environment
- Pets/Wildlife
- Small World
- Local Architecture

Digital adjustments and cropping are acceptable. The organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry to the competition for any reason.

4. How to Enter

Entries should be submitted via email to: community@redbourn-pc.gov.uk.

No more than 10 images may be submitted per person.

In the email entrants must provide the photographers name and age (if under 18), an email address and phone number and where the image was taken.

In submitting photographs entrants confirm the following:

- Photographs are the entrant's own work and they do not infringe copyright or other rights of any third party or any laws.
- They have gained consent of individuals identifiable in the photographs and/or consent of the parent/guardian in the case of under 18s. Furthermore, those individuals and/or parents/guardians in the case of under 18s, have been made aware that the images have been entered into the Redbourn Parish Council Photography Competition 2021 and maybe published by the council.
- They have received any necessary permissions from the owner(s) of objects including buildings identifiable in the photographs. Furthermore, those owner(s) have been made aware that the images have been entered into the Redbourn Parish Council Photography Competition 2021 and maybe published by the council.

Late, incomplete, or corrupt entries will not be accepted.

5. Usage Rights

By entering the competition, you grant Redbourn Parish Council non-exclusive rights to use the images to promote the work of the council (including future photography competitions) and for celebrating life and work in Redbourn parish.

You agree that publishing photographs as detailed in section 3 above includes: reproducing or displaying the images on the internet via Redbourn Parish Council's website, on social media, in and/or on the cover of Redbourn News, in exhibitions and in the window of Annie Griggs photography studio for the purpose of promoting the competition.

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6. Judging

All photos submitted and accepted according to the entry criteria and adherence to these terms and conditions will be posted on social media to promote the competition and for the enjoyment/engagement of the public.

Entries will then be shortlisted and judged by members of the Redbourn Parish Council Photography Competition Working Party (including local professional photographers Annie Griggs and Jeanette Lendon) plus a number of images put forward for a public vote via social media. In the case of the public vote the winning photograph will be the one with the majority of votes.

7. Announcement of winners

The winners will be announced at the Annual Parish Meeting on 11th May 2021 and if not present contacted by telephone or email as soon as possible after the event. Following the meeting winners will be publicly broadcast via social media and featured on and/or in the spring/summer edition of Redbourn News.
